As the largest provider of metal food packaging in the U.S.A, Silgan Containers is trusted by America's most respected brands. Our steel and aluminum containers and traditional and convenience ends are used by food processors to package fruit, vegetables, meat, coffee, soups, sauces, seafood, and pet food.

Silgan's Burlington, IA facility is a 412,000-square-foot state-of-the-art manufacturing plant. It was built from the ground up and began manufacturing cans in 2016. Today it is recognized as one of the most technically advanced steel food can plants in the country.

Silgan Burlington manufactures 300 and 307 diameter steel D&I cans with an output of approximately 1.350 billion cans a year. A hundred twenty-five full-time employees are working at this facility.
